14th Panzer Division:

- 4 weak panzer grenadier battalions
- 1 medium strength motorcycle battalion
- 1 cut up engineer battalion
- 6 light, 3 heavy, & 3 flak batteries
- 8 Panzer II
- 3 Panzer III (short)
- 29 Panzer III (long)
- 6 Panzer IV (short)
- 6 Panzer IV (long)
- 4 Command tanks

297th Infantry Division:

- 8 weak infantry battalions
- 1 cut up infantry battalions
- 1 medium strength engineer battalion
- 9 light & 3 heavy artillery batteries (70% mobile)

371st Infantry Division:

- 6 cut up & 2 weak infantry battalions
- 1 medium strength engineer battalion
- 6 light & 3 heavy artillery batteries (50% mobile)
- 80% motorcycles & 75% of trucks available

1st Rumanian Division:

- 2 strong, 4 medium & 1 cut up battalion
- 1 pioneer battalion (30% mobile)
- 9 light 76.2mm (Russian guns) btrys, 4 light 100mm Skoda howitzer btrys.
- 100% mobile

2nd Rumanian Division:

- 2 medium strength & 5 cut up infantry battalions
- 1 strong engineer battalion
- 9 light (76.2mm Russian guns) btrys & 4 100mm Skoda howitzer btrys (100% mobile)

4th Rumanian Division:

- 7 strong strength infantry battalions
- 9 light (76.2mm Russian guns) btrys, 4 100mm Skoda howitzer btrys (100% mobile)

20th Rumanian Division:

- 7 strong infantry battalions
- 1 strong engineer battalion
- 9 light (76.2mm Russian guns) btrys, 4 100mm Skoda howitzer btrys (100% mobile)
- 75% of vehicles available.

Key:

- Strong over 400 men
- Medium over 300 men
- Cut up over 200 men
- Weak under 200 men
