Patrícia Campos Mello has been the Washington Correspondent of O Estado de São Paulo (leading Brazilian daily newspaper, circulation 400.000) since October 2006. Before, she was a senior reporter covering International Trade, Macroeconomics and Politics for the same paper, since February 2002. She has also worked as a reporter with Valor Economico and Gazeta Mercantil, two daily financial newspapers in Brazil.

She held a Summer Job with The Wall Street Journal Americas in New York from June 2001 to September 2001. While she was working for Gazeta Mercantil, she was a foreign correspondent in Germany.

Patricia has a master's degree in Business and Economic Reporting from New York University. She graduated in Journalism from Universidade de São Paulo, where she was top 5 in the admissions exam and had a Grade 10 with Honors in the graduation thesis. Patricia was a transfer student at University of Texas at Austin in 1996, where her GPA was 4.0. She studied in a German high school in Sao Paulo. She speaks fluent English, German and Spanish, besides Portuguese.

She published a book about Brazil and India in April 2008 - "Índia - Da miséria à potência," Editora Planeta, and a book about Brazil and China in 2005 - "O mundo tem medo da China", Editora Mostarda.
