

<b>Course</b>	<b>Description</b>
<b>Basic Security Cooperation</b>	This class gives leaders an overview of security cooperation (SC) and security assistance (SA). Course focuses instruction on the differences in SC and SA and ties in security force assistance (SFA). Course further explains basic differences in authorities between Title 10 and Title 22 missions.
<b>Region / Country Orientation</b>	This class discusses regions and countries of interest focusing on issues that impact U.S. forces deploying to the area.
<b>Media Engagement</b>	This class explains how effective public affairs strategy helps internal and external audiences understand the operation and engender confidence in the force. The class also explains how media reduces the fear, suspicion, apprehension and misunderstanding which degrade operational effectiveness and how media interaction can help achieve strategic goals and how poor media interaction can erode established relationships.
<b>Foreign Security Forces (FSF) Training Management</b>	This class outlines considerations and techniques for training a FSF. It covers understanding, advising, and mentoring the FSF; understanding traditional beliefs and their influence on the mission and training; understanding the physical environment and socio-economic challenges of training FSF; and identifies steps to successfully train and advise.
<b>Embassy Operations</b>	This class provides an introduction to the Department of State (DOS), U.S. policy, DOS goals, US embassy organization, and protocol. The class will prepare the deploying soldiers to engage and coordinate with interagency personnel working in the area of operations.
<b>Nonstandard Weapons Familiarization</b>	This class utilizes foreign and nonstandard US weapons that students will come into contact with in the area of operations. Course is limited to weapons on hand: Avtomat Kalashnikova (AK-47) Dragunov Sniper Rifle (SVD) Rocket Propelled Grenade (RPG) Ruchnoy Pulemyot Kalashnikova (RPK) Pulemyot Kalashnikova (PKM) Course will include characteristics, assembly and disassembly, loading/unloading, and functions check of the weapon (No Live Fire). This class is only available during the resident course.
