Fort Bliss, Texas — Training and Doctrine Command school houses have dispatched instructors to Fort Bliss, Texas, for the Captains Career Course common core proof of principle. In January, TRADOC released the U.S. Army Learning Concept for 2015. It established a learner-centric education model that blurs the lines between operational assignments and military schooling while emphasizing a life-long learning continuum. This new learning concept was further refined by the School of Advanced Leadership and Tactics at the Command and General Staff College at Fort Leavenworth, with the development of the Mid-Grade Learning Continuum for 2015 concept, which covers the continuum of learning from first lieutenant through promotable captains.
