



- ✓ Reduce CG span of control
- ✓ Focus on functions (Capability Development, Knowledge, LDE&T, etc...)
- ✓ Confine efforts to CAC missions as outlines in regulations




CAC OPORD published 24 March 2008; Director FMD selected as CDID Director; Director BCID selected as Deputy CDID Director.

CAC-CDID Concept Paper (Version 2.5) coordinated in early April 2008; received concurrence from ARCIC.

CAC-CDID implementation plan approved with initiation of Phase II (Execution) effective **20 May 2008**.

CAC-CDID executes **capability development** and integration for **Combined Arms operations at the Division level and above** for specified areas in order to develop DOTMLPF- integrated Combined Arms capabilities that enhance our current force, supplement our future force and leverage existing joint capabilities.
