Selected to the Senior Executive Service in August 2007, Mr. Kirby R. Brown was appointed as the Deputy to the Commanding General, Fires Center of Excellence and Fort Sill, effective 19 August 2007. In this capacity, Mr. Brown works in collaboration with and under the general direction of the Commanding General in the development and execution of organizational goals, objectives, and policies to ensure Warfighting commanders receive world class Field Artillery and Air Defense Artillery Soldiers, equipment and organizations. Mr. Brown has full responsibility to direct the actions of the Center's 3500 military and civilian personnel, technical and managerial efforts, and \$220 million annual operating budget. He provides direct supervision to the Center's 700 military and civilian workforce engaged in Force Management and the development of capabilities, concepts, doctrine, organizations, training, materiel, leader education, personnel, and facilities. Additionally, he serves as the Commander's principal advisor and the Center's senior expert in force management, joint capabilities integration and development system, requirements determination, and material acquisition.

From Nov 2004- Aug 2007, Mr. Brown served as Director, US Army Space and Missile Defense Battle Lab, Future Warfare Center, US Army Space and Missile Defense Command/Army Strategic Command, Colorado Springs, CO. Between Aug 1999- Oct 2004, he was the Director, Space Directorate, US Army Space and Missile Defense Battle Lab, US Army Space and Missile Defense Command, Colorado Springs, CO. From Aug 1999-Feb 2003, he was the Senior Military Analyst, Institute for Defense Analyses, Washington, DC. Served as Director under an Inter-Departmental Personnel Agreement. From Apr 1998-Jul 1999, Mr. Brown was the Senior Military Analyst, Aegis Technologies, Huntsville, AL, and from Jun 1977- Mar 1998, he was on active duty with the Army.

Mr. Brown received an MS Degree in Logistics Management, Florida Institute of Technology, an MS in Education from Pittsburg State University. He earned his B.S Degree in Manufacturing Technology from Kansas State College of Pittsburg.
