Jamie Haunani Hatch is the Knowledge Management Officer (KMO) for the Commander, U.S. Pacific Fleet. She joined the COMPACFLT staff in July 2006 as the Lead Knowledge Management Support Specialist under contract with Computer Sciences Corporation and entered federal civil service as the Fleet KMO (YA-03) in September 2008. Working as a special assistant to the Commander and under the direction of the Fleet Chief Knowledge Officer (CKO), Ms. Hatch is responsible for coordinating knowledge and information management (KIM) activities for the COMPACFLT Maritime Operations Center (MOC). She was a lead action officer on the Maritime Headquarters with Maritime Operations Center (MHQ with MOC) planning team and most currently serves on the planning team for the Command and Control of Command and Control (C2 of C2) Initiative at COMPACFLT. Ms. Hatch co-leads the Pacific Fleet Knowledge and Information Management Working Group (KIMWG) for all PACFLT KM and IM personnel. She manages a team of 7 knowledge management advisors (KMA) supporting the Pacific Fleet in Yokosuka, Bremerton, San Diego and Hawaii.

Before working for COMPACFLT, Ms. Hatch was the Director of Web Services for Hawaii Pacific University in Honolulu. She spent the majority of her career working as a web developer, designer and applications engineer for the University of California at Santa Barbara (UCSB), Santa Barbara City College, several non-profit organizations, and her own independent consulting firm.

Ms. Hatch is a graduate of UCSB where she received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Cultural Anthropology with honors and distinction in the major. She received a Master of Science degree in Information Systems from Hawaii Pacific University. In 2008, Ms. Hatch was recognized as Rising Star in Technology by the Women of Color in Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM).
