### MILESTONES

*September 2003* – BCKS capabilities and requirements outlined.

*August 2004* – HQDA establishes BCKS at the U.S. Army Combined Arms Center (CAC).

*September 2004* – Army designates CG CAC as the proponent for BCKS.

*January 2005* – CAC initiates BCKS Mission.

*June 2007* – BCKS Pilot Program successfully completed.

*August 2007* – HQDA assigns CG CAC as the Army Operational Knowledge Management (AOKM) proponent with the responsibility for developing a KM program to institutionalize KM across Army doctrine, organizations, training, material, leadership and education, personnel, and facilities (DOTMLPF).

*August 2008* – FM 6-01.1 Knowledge Management Section is published.

*November 2008* – DA G3/5/7 Memorandum approves BCKS Concept Plan establishing initial proponent capabilities.

*July 2009* – 1<sup>st</sup> pilot of the Army Knowledge Management Qualification Course (AKMQC).

– KM Sections approved by HQDA for ASCCs (Army Service Component Commands), corps and divisions.

*September 2009* – Brigade Combat Team (BCT) holistic review retains KM Officer.

*November 2009* – HQDA approves the Skill Identifier (SI )/Additional Skill Identifier (ASI)of 1E (Knowledge Management Professional) for graduates from the AKMQC.

*January 2010* – 2<sup>nd</sup> pilot of the AKMQC.
