Lieutenant Colonel Liam Hale joined the Regular Army in January 1988. He graduated from the Royal Military College, Duntroon to the Royal Australian Artillery in mid 1989. His postings as a Lieutenant through to Major included appointments in 1st Construction Regiment, 17 Construction Squadron, Combat Command Wing, and the School of Military Engineering. .

In 2003 he gained operational experience as the Mines Officer on the Headquarters of the Multi National Division South West as part of the Stabilisation Force in the former Yugoslavia. On return from Bosnia he attended Australian Command and Staff College.

On graduation from Staff College Lieutenant Colonel Hale was appointed as the Australian Exchange Officer at the US Army National Simulation Centre at Fort Leavenworth Kansas. During his two years at the National Simulation Centre he was employed as both the TRADOC Schoolhouse Coordinator and the Chief of Operations Division of the Operations Directorate. On return to Australia, he was posted to the Land Warfare Development Centre as the Staff Officer Grade 1 Simulation.

As a result of the 2008 LWDC reorganisation the Army Knowledge Management Group was raised to meet the needs of the Army Learning Environment implementation. Lieutenant Colonel Hale was appointed as the Staff Officer Grade 1 Army Knowledge Management and as the Acting Director of the Group.
