He has been with the Army's Battle Command Knowledge System since Sep 2004 developing NCO Net and its sub-community. He was instrumental in helping NCO Net win the CIO/G6 2007 "Best Knowledge Transformation Initiative Award".

His Army career spanned 30 years (Sep 74 to Sep 04) as a tanker and Operations NCO. His last 17 years was in BDE S3 to C/J3 combined/joint positions. His last four assignments were; G3 SGM for 2nd AD/4TH ID (EXFOR) Fort Hood, TX where he was responsible for the digitization of the Army using the Army Battle Command Systems (ABCS); CAC-CAT SGM at Fort Leavenworth, KS continuing his support of digitizing the Army, working with BCTP and CALL, and moving part of the Army Joint Support Team school; CJG3 Sergeants Major, he helped with updating the TOC and was the CSM of USATC-K in Yongsan, Korea. In addition, he was the Chief Instructor for the Battle Staff Course, where he helped implement the ABCS boxes into the curriculum and Chief of Digital Training Division a new section within the Sergeants Major Academy blending simulation with ABCS, Ft Bliss, TX.
