The award of the Commendation Ribbon for meritorious service in Korea was made to 1st Lt Paul F Gorman, 772 Humphrey Street, Swampscott, recently. Lieutenant Colonel Trevor N Dupuy, Professor of Military Science and Tactics at Harvard University presented the decoration.

Lieutenant Gorman began his active service after graduating from West Point in 1950. Following graduation he attended the Parachute School at Ft Benning Ga, and then served with the 82d Airborne Division at Ft Bragg NC until his departure for Korea in February 1952.

The service for which Lt Gorman is being cited is described in part, in the official citation as follows: "1st Lt Paul F. Gorman, 1st Bn, 32nd Inf Regt, distinguished himself as Battalion Operations Officer during the period 14 October 1952 to 1 Jan 53. Lt Gorman, by his extensive knowledge of operations, his tireless efforts to keep abreast of the constantly changing situation, and his ability to coordinate the efforts of each unit, rendered a highly satisfactory service to the battalion and contributed directly to the many successes it enjoyed."

Lt Gorman is now preparing for duty as an instructor in Social Sciences at West Point by studying at the Harvard Graduate School of Public Administration.
