As outlined in the Army Training Concept 2012-2020 and [Field Manual 7-0](#), the Army is changing its direction for unit training and leader development – returning to Commander-driven training. The most recent [CAC-T SENDS](#) update to Brigade and Battalion Commanders highlights a variety of helpful training resources and tools, from virtual simulators to Military Operations on Urban Terrain (MOUT) facilities for increasing small unit readiness, ready-to-use training support packages to C-IED training aids and devices you can order.

Continue to share your feedback on DTMS response times. Sign in to the [survey tool](#) to record the time to perform five one-step DTMS functions. Frequent data from multiple locations will help pinpoint and correct response time issues.



DTMS is moving forward with a number of initiatives to improve overall service to its users. The team will soon be physically moving its operational servers to Ft Knox NEC to improve service delivery. Additionally, DTMS is adding new interfaces to increase automated data exchange and auto-population of training records – reducing manual data entry across the Army by more than 20,000 man-hours.
