Mr. Kirby R. Brown was appointed as the Deputy to the Commanding General, Combined Arms Center (CAC) and Fort Leavenworth, Kansas effective 16 July 2012. As such, he will assist the CAC Commanding General in overseeing four Major Subordinate Organizations located on Fort Leavenworth, and 17 other schools, centers, and training programs located throughout the United States



Mr. Brown was selected to the Senior Executive Service in August 2007, and was appointed as the Deputy to the Commanding General, Fires Center of Excellence and Fort Sill, effective 19 August 2007. In this capacity, Mr. Brown worked in collaboration with and under the general direction of the Commanding General in the development and execution of organizational goals, objectives, and policies to ensure the Warfighting commanders receive world class Field Artillery and Air Defense Artillery Soldiers, equipment and organizations.

Prior to serving as an SES, Mr. Brown held numerous positions to include Director of US Army Space and Missile Defense Battle Lab in Colorado Springs, CO, Senior Military Analyst Institute for Defense Analyses in Washington, DC, and Senior Military Analyst, Aegis Technologies, Huntsville, AL.
