Welcome! We are excited that you are here (or soon will be) and look forward to working with you and your Family to make sure you have the information you need to better prepare you for your assignment to the home of Army Aviation. Families can choose to relocate to the Fort Rucker area while their Soldier is in training, while others choose to relocate after graduation from Warrant Officer Candidate School. Whatever your decision, know that we are here to assist you in any way we can.



Students of 1st WOC are not “permanently” assigned to the Warrant Officer Career College. Many students will complete their WOC training and move onto their next school and duty assignment. For other students, that assignment will be here at Fort Rucker – Flight School. Congratulations!!

Because of the dynamics and length of time for 1st WOC training, there is no student dedicated Family Readiness Group (FRG). In an effort to still provide information to spouses and provide a source to ask any questions you may have, the United States Army Aviation Center of Excellence (USAACE) Family Readiness Support Assistant (FRSA) will serve as a point of contact for information / questions / issues / concerns for Families of 1st WOC students. **The USAACE FRSA’s office is located on 7th Avenue. On the day of graduation, if your Soldier will be attending Flight School, he/she will attend unit in-processing for B Co. 1-145th. The in-processing can take several hours depending on the number of graduating students attending Flight School. While the students are in-processing we offer the Families a “Warm Welcome” providing them information about housing (to include a tour, if desired), employment opportunities, and Army Community Service (ACS). The unit Commander also provides information about what Soldiers and Families of Flight School can expect.
