

# Military History Instructors Course (MHIC)

3-13 January 2012

Fort Leavenworth, Kansas

## INFORMATION SHEET

1. Arrival/Report Date for the course is **2 JANUARY 2012**. Return Travel date is **14 JANUARY 2012 (see #14 below)**.
2. The course director will be present in the lobby of the IGH Army Hotel at Hoge Barracks on Fort Leavenworth (Grant Ave. and Stimson Ave.) from **1800-1900 on Monday, 2 January** to answer any questions and provide maps to the classroom.
3. Government Transportation is not provided from Kansas City International Airport to Ft. Leavenworth. Brigades are encouraged to authorize rental cars for attendees.
4. Suggested Lodging for the course is the IGH Army Hotel at Hoge Barracks on Ft. Leavenworth. 913-684-4091. However, students may make other lodging arrangements at hotels in the local area. (A lodging information sheet is attached.)
5. The MO-92 Bridge over the Missouri River was limited to one lane due to construction before flooding in June 2011 postponed work on the bridge. If it resumes, this construction will affect those attendees staying at hotels on the Missouri side of the river. When the work is rescheduled, it will be posted to the CSI website.
6. ID Cards are required to enter FT. Leavenworth. Vehicle security searches are conducted periodically.
7. Parking is available on Ft. Leavenworth within a 5-8 minute walk of the course classroom. (see parking map provided.)
8. The course classroom is scheduled to be **DePuy Auditorium of Eisenhower Hall**.
9. While the majority of the course will be conducted in the classroom, outdoor activities will include a historic weapons firing range and a staff ride for the Battle of Westport in Kansas City. Both will be conducted regardless of the weather, so students need to bring inclement weather clothing.
10. Uniform for the course is ACU for active duty personnel and dress casual for civilian (collared shirt, pants). Civilian clothes are authorized for all students for the Staff Ride and on the arrival and departure travel dates.
11. The course classroom is located in close proximity to the Combined Arms Research Library (CARL) and a number of food establishments, primarily in the Lewis and Clark Center.
12. At the beginning of the course, students will be provided with two textbooks that provide the majority of the readings for the course.
13. Duty hours for the course will normally be 0830-1600, with an hour break for lunch. Some days' timelines will vary.
14. The course will conclude at **1600 on 13 JANUARY**. No return travel plans should be made prior **1800** on that date.
