

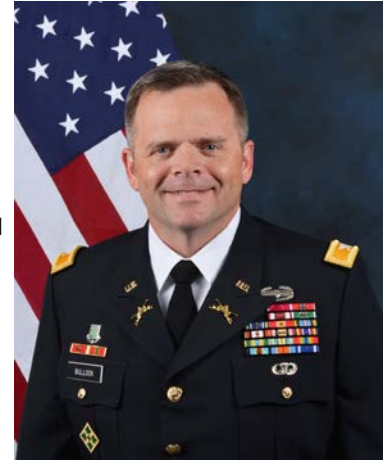

## Colonel Jay P. Bullock

Colonel Jay Bullock was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant in Armor from Stephen F. Austin State University in Nacogdoches, Texas, in 1993. Following the Armor Officer Basic Course he reported to the 3rd Infantry Division in Vilseck, Germany, and served as Tank Platoon Leader in 2-37 AR and deployed to Macedonia in support of Operation Able Sentry as a Company Executive Officer and later the Support Platoon Leader.



After completing the Armor Officer Advanced Course, Colonel Bullock was assigned to the 1<sup>st</sup> Cavalry Division, Fort Hood, Texas, where he served as the Brigade Operations Officer, Assistant S3 and deployed to Bosnia-Herzegovina in support of the Stabilization Force (SFOR) in 1998. Upon redeployment he commanded Delta Company, 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion, 12<sup>th</sup> Cavalry Regiment. In 2001 he was assigned to Fort Knox, Kentucky, where he served as an Observer, Controller, Trainer, in 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion, 409<sup>th</sup> Infantry Regiment and as a Small Group instructor at the Armor Captains Career Course, 3d Battalion, 16<sup>th</sup> Cavalry Regiment.

Upon graduation from the Command and General Staff College, he was assigned to 3d Brigade, 4<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division at Fort Carson, Colorado. COL Bullock served in a variety of positions including a Military Transition Team Chief for an Iraqi Infantry Battalion in Diyala Province, 4<sup>th</sup> Squadron, 10<sup>th</sup> Cavalry S3 and XO, and the BCT XO. He deployed three times in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. In 2011 he was assigned to 4<sup>th</sup> Brigade, 4<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division as a Stability Force Advise and Assist Team Chief and deployed to Afghanistan where he advised an Afghan Infantry Battalion in Kunar Province.

In 2013 he was assigned to US Army Europe, USAREUR HQ, in Wiesbaden, Germany where he served as the Chief of Operations and the Executive Officer to the G-3/5/7.

His military awards and decorations include the Bronze Star Medal, Army Meritorious Service Medal, Army Commendation Medal, Army Achievement Medal, and Combat Action Badge.
