Mr. Robert G. Longino is currently the Director of the Department of Academic Support and Distributed Learning at the Army Management Staff College. He has over 40 years of professional experience as an active duty Marine as well as public service at both the state and federal level. His professional career began when he



was commissioned as an Officer of Marines, where he served just over twenty years in a variety of assignments before retiring and moving back to Kansas. Upon his retirement he was asked to serve as the Director of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division for the state of Kansas. In that capacity he served as the state's chief regulatory official, overseeing the alcoholic beverage industry in Kansas.

Transitioning from state government, Mr. Longino joined the faculty of the Command and General Staff College, Fort Leavenworth, Kansas. During his tenure with CGSC, he served in three positions. Initially hired as faculty member in the Department of Army Tactics, he serve five years as a CGSOC course facilitator and then three years as the department's Chief of Curriculum. He subsequently assumed duties as the Deputy Director of Command and General Staff School's Department of Distance Education. He served in that capacity for four plus years before assuming his new position with AMSC.

Mr. Longino's civilian education includes a BS in Education from the University of Kansas and a MA in Educational Psychology from the University of Oklahoma. He is also a graduate of the Command and General Staff Officer Course, Fort Leavenworth, KS, the Joint Military Professional Education Phase 2 Course, Joint Forces Staff College, Norfolk, VA, the Amphibious Warfare School, Quantico, VA, and numerous other professional military education courses.
