Students who have successfully completed the Intermediate-Level Education (ILE) Common Core at Army Command and General Staff College (CGSC) will receive 15 credits that can be applied toward a UMUC Master of Science (MS) in management with a specialization in army operations and national security, provided that they have sent in their transcripts, applied for admission to UMUC, and been accepted. Students will be notified when their credits are posted.

Those who wish to pursue their education further can earn an MBA by completing 18 additional credits after meeting the requirements for the MS in management. Active-duty military personnel are eligible for in-state graduate tuition.

UMUC is the largest public university in the United States and a recognized leader in adult education. With more than 60 years of experience providing education services to the U.S. military, the university enrolls 50,000 active-duty service members, reservists, veterans, and their family members at more than 150 classroom and service locations in 27 countries.
