



The National Simulation Center's (NSC) Global Simulation Capability (GSC) provides a simulation training enabler for division and corps staffs to improve their readiness. The GSC provides a high-quality constructive simulation, the Multi-Resolution Federation – Warfighters Simulation (MRF-W). MRF-W is optimized to support division and corps level operations, enabling complete validation of deployable command post capability.

GSC exercise support templates are flexible and responsive. The range of support can include an Army National Guard drill weekend Command Post Exercise (CPX) lasting only 16 hours, a sustainment focused CPX for an Expeditionary Sustainment Command, or a 10-day Warfighter exercise home station CPX supporting a division or corps.

Exercise database preparation is responsive, and the GSC can construct a simulation database as quickly as six weeks. GSC simulation support is a flexible commanders' tool focused on training objectives and tailorable to leaders' training requirements. It enables dynamic training experiences for division and corps staffs.
