BG Katherine Trombley earned a commission in the Quartermaster Corps through the University of Washington ROTC program in June of 1996. Upon completion of the Quartermaster Officer Basic Course in Fort Lee, VA, her first duty station was in Baumholder, GE, with the 47th Forward Support Battalion, 1st Armored Division. Since then she has served in both active and reserve units; 25th Forward Support Battalion, 25th Infantry Division; 4th Brigade, 91st Training Support Division; Seattle Recruiting Battalion; 70th Regional Support Command; 494th Brigade Support Battalion; 311th Expeditionary Sustainment Command; and 364th Expeditionary Sustainment Command.

BG Trombley deployed to Afghanistan with the CENTCOM Material Recovery Element, 82nd Sustainment Brigade, 1st Theater Support Command Forward, in support of Operation Enduring Freedom.
