

Colonel Christopher S. Moretti, Sr.

Chief Operations Group, Operations Group-Bravo

Colonel Christopher S. Moretti Sr. graduated from the University of Rhode Island and was commissioned in the Field Artillery. While in the University of Rhode Island, he simultaneously served in the 103d Field Artillery Brigade, Rhode Island Army National Guard. Upon entering active duty, Colonel Moretti's initial assignment was in the 2d Battalion 2d Field Artillery at Fort Sill which he served as a Platoon Fire Direction Officer (FDO), Platoon Leader, Battalion Fire Director Officer, Assistant S3 and Battery Commander.

Following completion of the Field Artillery Officer Advanced Course and the Combined Arms and Services Staff School (CAS3), he then served in the 82d Airborne Division as the Division G1 Chief, Officer Management Branch (OMB); Battalion Fire Support Officer (FSO) for 1st Battalion, 325th Parachute Infantry Regiment; and Commander for Bravo Battery, 3d Battalion, 319th Airborne Field Artillery Regiment.

As a field grade officer, he served in the 2d Brigade, 91st Division as a Battery Commander and Battalion Operations Officer for 2d Battalion, 362d Field Artillery Regiment at Fort Carson in support of Operation Noble Eagle. After completing Command General Staff Officer College at Fort Leavenworth, Colonel Moretti served as a Future Operations Planner and the Chief of Plans for Coalition Forces Land Component Command (CFLCC) in support of both Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation Enduring Freedom. Subsequently, he served again in the 82d Airborne Division as the Brigade Fire Support Officer for the 505th Parachute Infantry Regiment in support of Task Force Katrina. Colonel Moretti then served as the Task Force Operations Officer and Task Force Executive Officer for 1st Battalion, 319th Airborne Field Artillery Regiment in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom.

Colonel Moretti served as the Corps Targeting Officer, Fires Coordination Branch in the NATO Rapid Deployable Corps Italy located in Solbiate Olona, Italy. During his North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) assignment, he served as the International Security Assistance Force and United States Forces Afghanistan Chief of Targets. He also served as a Targeting Instructor at the NATO School Targeting Course in Oberammergau, Germany and served as the primary targeting trainer and subject matter expert for the Joint Warfare Center Mission Readiness Exercise in Stavanger, Norway.

Colonel Moretti commanded the 4th Battalion, 27th Field Artillery Regiment at Fort Bliss. Following battalion command, he served as the Division Chief of Fires for the 10th Mountain Division at Fort Drum where he was selected for Senior Service College. After graduating the United States Army War College at Carlisle Barracks, he served again in the 82d Airborne Division as Commander, 82d Airborne Division Artillery (DIVARTY). During his most recent operational deployment to Afghanistan, he served as the Senior Advisor to the Afghan Minister of Defense, Headquarters Resolute Support. Following the deployment, he served as the Chief of Staff, Joint Readiness Training Center and Fort Polk. He currently serves as the Chief Operations Group, Operations Group Bravo (OPS GRP-B), Mission Command Training Program (MCTP) at the Combined Arms Center Fort Leavenworth.
