Military Academy at West Point in 1987. His operational assignments include the 82nd Airborne Division, 5th Infantry Division, 2nd Armored Division, 4th Infantry Division, and 1st Cavalry Division. He deployed in support of Operation Just Cause, Operation Desert Shield/Desert Storm, and Operation Iraqi Freedom.

Following his retirement from active duty in 2008, Mr. Brewington served in a variety of Army Civilian positions to include Program Manager, Multi-Source Assessment and Feedback Program; Chief of Operations and Integration, Combined Arms Center Capability Development and Integration Directorate; Combined Arms Center G-37; Senior Military Analyst for Training and Leader Development, Mission Command Center of Excellence; G-3, Mission Command Center of Excellence; and Deputy Assistant Chief of Staff G-3/5/7, U.S. Army Combined Arms Center.

Mr. Brewington's education includes a master's degree in Adult, Occupational, and Continuing Education from Kansas State University. He also holds a Bachelor of Science Degree in Military History from the United States Military Academy and is a graduate of the Army's Command and General Staff College at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas.
