



## Colonel Jason H. Rosenstrauch

Colonel Jason H. Rosenstrauch is the Deputy Commanding Officer, U.S. Army Combined Arms Center; Provost, Army University; and Deputy Commandant, U.S. Army Command and General Staff College at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas. Prior to his arrival to Fort Leavenworth, he served as the Chief of Staff, 3rd Infantry Division, Fort Stewart, Georgia.

Colonel Rosenstrauch is a graduate of Purdue University where he earned a Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering and a commission into the U.S. Army as an Armor Officer. He holds master's degrees from the School of Advanced Military Studies in Fort Leavenworth, Kansas, and the U.S. Army War College in Carlisle, Pennsylvania.
