Lieutenant General Robert B. Brown currently serves as the commander of the U.S. Army Combined Arms Center at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas. Lieutenant General Brown leads the synchronization of leader development across the Army, the management of the Army's training support and training development enterprises, and the development and integration of the doctrine the U.S. Army uses to fight and win our Nation's wars.

Prior to becoming the Commander of the Combined Arms Center on February 13, 2014, he was the Commander, I Corps and Joint Base Lewis-McChord, Washington, from 3 July 2012 to 6 February 2014

Lieutenant General Brown was commissioned a second lieutenant of Infantry from the United States Military Academy in May 1981, and he has served in many leadership positions from platoon level to Corps.

He served as a Platoon Leader and a Company Commander in mechanized infantry units at Fort Carson, Colorado; a Battalion Commander of a mechanized infantry battalion at Fort Hood, Texas including a deployment to Bosnia-Herzegovina in support of OPERATION JOINT FORGE; a Stryker Brigade Commander at Fort Lewis, Washington, including a deployment in support of OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM; and Commanding General of the Maneuver Center of Excellence (Infantry and Armor Forces) and Fort Benning, Georgia.

Lieutenant General Brown has also served in numerous staff positions including: Assistant Professor of Military Science and Deputy Director, Center of Enhanced Performance, United States Military Academy; Plans Officer at the United States Army Pacific (USARPAC); Operations Officer, Executive Officer and Chief, G-3 Training in the 25th Infantry Division including a deployment in support of OPERATION UPHOLD DEMOCRACY in Haiti; Personnel Assignment Officer in Human Resources Command (previously Total Army Personnel Command); Aide-de-Camp/Assistant Executive Officer to the Vice Chief of Staff, Army; Plans Officer in the Department of the Army G-3/5/7; a Program Analyst in the Dominant Maneuver Assessment Division, Joint Staff (J8); Executive Assistant to the Pacific Command Commander and Director, J-7 (Training and Exercises) at the United States Pacific Command (PACOM) Headquarters; Deputy Commanding General for Support of the 25th Infantry Division including a deployment in support of OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM; and Chief of Staff United States Army Europe (USAREUR) / Deputy Commanding General US Army NATO.

Lieutenant General Brown's decorations include the Distinguished Medal (with two Oak Leaf Clusters), the Defense Superior Service Medal, the Legion of Merit, the Bronze Star Medal (with Oak Leaf Cluster), the Defense Meritorious Service Medal, the Meritorious Service Medal (with Oak Leaf Cluster), and the Joint Service Commendation Medal, the Army Commendation Medal (with three Oak Leaf Clusters) and the Army Achievement Medal. He has earned the Combat Infantryman Badge, the Expert Infantryman Badge, the Parachutist Badge, the Air Assault Badge, the Joint Chiefs of Staff Identification Badge and the Army Staff Identification Badge.

Lieutenant General Brown holds a Bachelor of Science from the United States Military Academy, a Master of Education with Instructional Technology emphasis from the University of Virginia, and a Master of Science in National Security and Strategic Studies from National Defense University.
