

**ARTICULATION OF
UNDERSTANDING
Between
U.S. ARMY WARRANT OFFICER CAREER COLLEGE
And
UNIVERSITY OF CHARLESTON**

1. Purpose of Articulation Agreement. This agreement establishes the terms for the awarding of course credit from University of Charleston (UC) (OPIED 00381800) for Warrant Officer candidates and Senior Warrant Officers attending the U.S. Army Warrant Officer Career College (USAWOCC). The applicable courses and associated credit are identified in Annex A.

2. Background. HRC-Army Continuing Education Division (ACED) in October of 2017 released a "request for programs" (RFP). This RFP went to all schools on the GoArmyEd (GAE) website to propose their associates and bachelor degree programs toward leadership for selection by a board based on developed criteria. UC was selected to be one of the programs best suited for Soldiers.

4. Program.

a. Registration. Soldier participation is voluntary. Soldiers who wish to benefit from this agreement will have two weeks from the start of the applicable course to register with and pay any associated fees to UC.

b. Funding. UC will ensure participating Soldiers are aware of all fees and charges before they register. Soldiers who participate are personally responsible for paying all costs associated with their participation. This agreement does not establish any additional programs wherein the Army, relevant installation, or Army University will


fund a Soldier's participation. Soldiers who participate are responsible for determining their eligibility for Tuition Assistance or other official educational benefits.

c. Course Credit and Degree Plans. This program is designed to assist participating Soldiers with obtaining a degree from UC by obtaining academic credit for their military education and experience . This program includes the following degree program s: Bachelor of Science in Organizational Leadership. To obtain a degree, participating Soldiers must complete all additional general education courses, elective courses , and core courses required for the degree. Annex A identifies the available degree programs and the amount of credit that can be earned toward it from each Warrant Officer professional course.

d. Program Commitment. UC commits to providing eligible Soldiers the credit as outlined in Annex A Once a Soldier enrolls, the number and type of credit outlined in Annex A at the time of enrollment will not change to the detriment of the Soldier. Once the Soldier pays all associated costs, the appropriate credit will be added to the Soldier's official UC transcript. USAWOCC commits to advertising this agreement at the Education Center and other locations as well as on appropriate websites as permitted by Army regulations and policy.

5. **Tuition**. For students in the Program, University of Charleston will charge a tuition rate of \$250.00 per semester hour (SH) for face-to-face courses and \$250.00SH for online courses for School Year 2017-18, if active duty military or on an active reserve status. The tuition rate is approved annually by the University of Charleston Board of Trustees. The MOS Academic Credit Program administration fee is \$0.00. Even though semester fees are waived for those students utilizing Tuition Assistance (TA), there may be other miscellaneous fees associated with degree/course completion.


6. **Effective Date and Termination**. This agreement will be effective from the date signed by the and representative of the University of Charleston and will have a duration of three years. Upon expiration, this Agreement will be subject to renewal. Additions and changes to this Agreement may be made at any time with written agreement of both USAWOCC and UC. Either party may terminate this Agreement upon 60 days written notice to the other party via U.S. Certified mail. Termination must be in writing and signed by the approving officials or their designated representatives.
