SUBJECT: Commandant's Welcome Letter


1. Congratulations on your selection to attend United States Army Warrant Officer Intermediate Level Education (WOILE).
2. The mission of the United States Warrant Officer Career College (USAWOCC) is to educate and develop Warrant Officers to be able to lead, compete, and win in Multi-Domain Operations. The purpose of WOILE is provide CW3's and CW4s with the intermediate level education and influential leadership skills necessary to integrate their technical expertise in support of leaders as staff officers, trainers, managers, systems integrators, and leaders at the tactical and operational levels of Army, Joint, Interagency, Intergovernmental and multinational (JIIM) organizations executing Unified Land Operation through Decisive Actions.

In light of this reality, at USAWOCC you will engage in five weeks of professional military education (PME) designed around rigorous academics and littered with personal and professional development opportunities. This is a major career milestone that affords you the opportunity to grow as a warrant officer and leader in the profession of arms. Over the course of the upcoming five weeks, you will engage with curriculum covering a wide spectrum of academia that will hone your expertise and skills.

The academics are unapologetically demanding because your commands require a capitalization on your newly acquired knowledge, skills, and attributes you will develop over the five weeks while attending WOILE. 5. Your classmates at WOILE will include some of the highest caliber warrant officers with diverse backgrounds. You will be taught by a top-notch faculty with BAs, MAs, and PhDs and receive personal mentorship from experienced military and civilian leaders. Year after year, past graduates mention the value of the relationships they developed

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while attending WOILE. Completion of this course also provides the opportunity to participate in six cooperative degree programs from regionally accredited universities where you may be awarded between 15 to 30 semester hours or more towards an Associate, Bachelor's or Master's degree.
