Notes

#1 - These two grenadier battalions were formed from 14 grenadier companies detached from the 1st and 2nd battalions of all the seven regiments of Laval's and Ruffin's divisions, including the 16th Légère Regiment, which was absent from the corps. The total strength of these battalions is already provided in the parent battalions, save the 16th Légère Regiment's strength, which was 7 officers and 170 men. The total French strength is, therefore, about 7,170.
