Digital Master Gunner (DMG) Branch

(note: A Mission Command Digital Master Gunner is a Subject Matter Expert that can operate, maintain, integrate, and train others on C2 applications to generate a COP for the Commander.)

- ➤ Employ Command Post Computing Environment (CPCE) as a C2 system
- ➤ Integrate, visualize, and troubleshoot digital WfF systems
- Provide C2 application support to unit DMGs after course graduation
